

JUNIOR BREEDING HEIFER DIVISION

ENTRY FEE: \$35.00 PER ANIMAL

ENTRIES CLOSE NOVEMBER 20, 2017

(Fees must accompany entries)

Arrival and Release Times:

The same as open breeding cattle of the respective breeds.

1. Rules and Regulations. General Rules and Regulations apply to this division as well as those listed in Junior Livestock Show Rules and Regulations and those rules listed in each specific division, ie: Angus, Charolais, etc. Any violation of the rules and regulations will automatically result in disqualification with no recourse.

2. To be eligible to exhibit in this division, exhibitors must be enrolled and a member in good standing in 4-H or FFA or a member of a Junior Breed Association, being eight (8) years of age and not more than twenty one (21) years as of January 1, 2018. Junior Breed Associations must verify age and eligibility of their members if over 4-H age limit.

3. Junior breeding heifers may be entered in the open show in the name of the Junior using an Open Breeding Cattle entry form. Late entries according to General Rules #16.

4. A participant will be limited to two places in any one (1) individual class.

5. Only one (1) person per animal is permitted in the show arena during the exhibition of individual classes.

6. Nurse cows are not permitted.

7. All heifers must be registered in the National Herd Book of the breed. The entry must show the name, the age and the registration number of the competing animal.

8. Participant must be enrolled in the project in which they are exhibiting. **All heifers must be the property of and in the possession of the Participant as of November 20, 2017.** Ownership must be shown by breed registry issue/transfer date. Registration must be in the name of Participant as of December 1st. Those heifers sold in Breed Association sales should be allowed to be shown by Junior Exhibitor entering the heifer with approval of the new owner.

9. Classes may be divided or combined at the discretion of Stock Show with the same premium money paid in each class.

10. Substitutions within the same class and same owner only will be accepted. There will be no substitution of animals in different classes. Only one (1) substitution for original animal will be allowed. Substitutions must be in writing and postmarked by United States, Canadian or International Postal Service no later than December 10, 2017. No postage meters will be accepted. No substitutions will be allowed after that date.

11. There are **NO SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES** in the Junior Breeding Heifer Division.

12. No fans attached to a cart or dolly. All fans must be suspended.

All rules for Simmental open show apply to this division. Females in this division must be registered in the American Simmental Association (1/2-blood or higher are accepted in this show).

Junior show heifers must be checked in & processed with open class entries on Sunday afternoon, Jan. 14th on the hill. Original registration certificates on each animal must be available for inspection. The heifer must be in the junior's name; no farm name or authorized user allowed. (National Western's Junior Livestock rule #8) to show. Any animal not having a legible tattoo which matches the registration certificate will be barred from showing.
