1. Each exhibitor in this show will pay a fee of seventy (\$70.00) dollars per head entered. All Entry fees must be mailed to the National Western Stock Show or enter online at www.nationalwest-ern.com. All fees must be paid in United States funds.

2. All animals must be registered with the American Simmental Association. Animals competing in purebred classes must be 7/8-blood Simmental or higher. Animals competing in the percentage classes must be between 1/2-blood and less than 7/8-blood Simmental.

3. All animals must have a legible tattoo or hide brand that matches its ASA registration number.

4. For safety, all animals must be dehorned, and all bulls twelve (12) months of age or older must be shown with a nose lead or ring.

5. **NEW: Check-in will take place at the ASA booth, located inside the NWSS Stockyards Arena, between 2:30-4:30 p.m. Sunday, January 19, 2020.**

The exhibitor or their representative must come in-person and declare which of their entries are on site and should be checked in for the show. Animals and/or registration papers are not required to be brought to this check-in.

Certification of the following must be provided to check-in personnel:

a. Any bulls fifteen (15) months of age or older must have veterinary proof of a semen test and/or breeding soundness exam and must be proven as a satisfactory breeder.

b. Any female eighteen (18) months of age or older must be a) certified pregnant by a licensed non-owner veterinarian, or b) have certification that she has been used in embryo transfer.

Corresponding back tags then will be issued to entries that have complete show eligibility & this new check-in process.

6. **NEW:** All first and second place animals in each class will have tattoos/brands verified before entering the ring for division championship. If a tattoo or brand cannot be verified, that animal is disqualified from entering the ring for division championship. Should an animal be disqualified, reasonable efforts will be made to move lower placing animals up.

7. **NEW: Tattoos on other animals may be checked at the discretion of ASA or CSA staff. ASA staff also reserves the right to pull DNA samples on any animal.**

8. Cow/calf division will show first on Wednesday. In all other cases, female and bull show order is youngest to oldest in purebred and then percentage divisions. Animals will enter the ring starting with the youngest first. All must be in the makeup area before the conclusion of the prior class. Any animal not at ring side when its class enters the ring will be scratched.

9. **Exhibitors are encouraged to run HD testing on their animals prior to the show. Genomically enhanced EPDs are noted in the show program.**

10. CSA reserves the right to bar any animal/exhibitor from the show who does not meet these show requirements. ACCUMILATED POINTS

Premier Exhibitor: Animals must be owned or co-owned by the exhibitor. Award based on points accumulated in individual classes. One (1) point will be awarded for each animal an individual is placed above in his or her individual class. (Example: in a class of 8, first (1st) place will receive seven (7) points, second (2nd) place will receive six (6) points, etc) And one point will be awarded for division winners.....D

Premier Breeder: Breeder is defined as individual(s) or organization(s) listed as breeder on the registration paper and identified by ASA breeder ID number. Award based on points accumulated in individual classes on animals bred (but not necessarily owned or exhibited) by one (1) individual or firm. Same point system as Premier Exhibitor.....D
