# **Eligibility:**

- Have not had their 22<sup>nd</sup> birthday as of January 1, 2021
- Have paid an annual membership fee of \$25 to RMJSA

# **Ownership**:

Registrations and transfer of ownership must be recorded in the sole name of the exhibitor per national rules. The issue date on the registration paper must read no later than <u>May 15<sup>th</sup></u>.

# **Entry Deadline:**

All entries must be postmarked or emailed no later than <u>May 15<sup>th</sup></u>. Late entrees may be accepted per the discretion of the show superintendent.

**Cattle Check-In:** Will be from 12pm-1pm on Saturday June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

- **TATTOOS:** Any animal upon check-in which does not have a legible tattoo corresponding to its registration paper will be ineligible to show. Once disqualified, animals cannot be re-tattooed and re-checked at the show.
- Registration Papers must be presented at check-in.
- All entry, registration and eligibility requirements must be met at the time of inspection as described in the ASA General Rules-Eligibility of Exhibitors and Entries.
- All cattle must be stalled in the Morgan County beef barn, NO stalling off of trailers is allowed.

**Showing:** These rules apply to all RMJSA exhibitors

- Breed Bash is a "no fit below and go" show. No adhesives, glue, or paint permitted.
- No stomach pumping or artificial fillers allowed.
- Exhibitors in showmanship must use their own animal properly entered.
- Each entry must be shown by its owner. If an owner cannot show his/her animal, permission must be obtained from the executive board for another member to show it.
- Only one person will be allowed to lead each entry in the showring.
- Any exhibitor who loses control of his/her entry in the showring more than 3 times will be asked to remove the animal from the showring.

#### Showmanship Classes: Age as of January 1, 2021

- Senior Ages 18-21
- Intermediate Ages 14-17
- Junior Ages 13 and under

Beef Classes: Classes may be divided if the number of entries warrants.
