SALE REGULATIONS

1. Sale entries DUE NOVEMBER 15, 2022.
2. All consignors shall be in good standings with the American Simmental Association.
3. All entries must be registered with the American Simmental Association. ***Pedigree information, nomination form, nomination fee & footnotes must be to M3 Marketing by Nov. 15, 2022.***
4. **NEW REQUIREMENT - All entries must be completely DNA tested, including parentage, through ASA and Neogen. It will be at no cost to consignors through a sponsorship from Neogen. With your consignment, Neogen will issue a "No Charge" testing credit. Call ASA now for your kits! 5. All cattle sell under the sale terms and conditions of the American Simmental Association.
6. REGISTRATION AND OWNERSHIP. Consignor must own all entries at the time of nomination.
7. TATTOOS. Tattoos will be verified at sale site and must be correct with ASA registration papers. Please check tattoos before entries are made. Tattoos and OVC tattoos must be legible!

SALE EXPENSE

1. Nomination Fee. All lots (Bull, heifer, donor, pregnancy, flush or pick of herd) will have a nomination fee of two hundred dollars (\$200) US per lot. Embryo Packages and Semen will be one-hundred (\$100) per lot. Checks payable to M3 Marketing and mailed in with nomination form.
2. Nominations not accepted-100% refund.
3. Nominations accepted but sifted in Denver. 50% refund of nomination fee less pro-rated sale costs.
4. Nominations accepted-no shows will forfeit nomination fee. All cattle are subject to final inspection upon arrival at the sale site. In the event of a sale animal failing to be a breeder or being returned to the seller for any reason whatsoever, neither sale management, sanctioning group nor auctioneer shall be responsible for the return of any commission or entry fees earned at the time of The One and Only Simmental Sale.
5. Transfer fees will be retained by M3 and remitted to ASA.
6. Sale commission of the gross sale price and prorated sale costs will be deducted from consignor's proceeds. The nomination fee will be applied to sale costs.

SALE HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

1. BRUCELLOSIS – FEMALES AND BULLS
 1. Official Calvhod Vaccinated (OCV) with a legible vaccination tattoo.
 2. Females 24 months of age and over must test negative within 30 days prior to sale date or be from a certified free herd.
 3. Bulls six months of age and over must test negative within 30 days prior to sale date or be from a USDA certified free herd.
2. TUBERCULOSIS – All breeding animals must be tested and negative within 60 days prior to sale date or be from a USDA accredited herd. If from a USDA accredited herd, list the last whole herd test date. If the animals are coming from Michigan, please visit the website at www.colorado.gov/aganimals or call the Colorado State Veterinarian's office at (303) 869-9130 for complete testing details.
3. BOVINE VIRAL DIARRHEA (BVD) – Must be tested negative for BVD persistently infected (PI) status PRIOR to arrival at NWSS. Those without a documented negative test will not be allowed on the grounds. Pooled samples are accepted so long as individual animal identification is maintained and documented. One negative test per animal is sufficient per lifetime. Acceptable tests include immunohistochemistry(IHC), antigen-capture ELISA (ac-ELISA), polymerase chain reaction (PCR) and virus isolation (VI). Please note: BVD serology or titers are not accepted.
4. SCABIES – All animals must have been officially treated for Scabies by the following: treated with an Ivermectin or Ivermectin-like product(s) at required dose, according to label directions, between 1 and 10 days prior to arrival on NWSS grounds. If sold, some states of destination may require additional treatments. NWSS veterinarian(s) will address if required.
5. TRICHOMONIASIS – All sale bulls 12 months of age or older shall have a negative individual PCR T. fetus test within 30 days prior to entry to the NWSS. No female contact after negative trich test.
6. ANAPLASMOSIS AND BLUE TONGUE – A test is optional within 30 days of sale date, as animals may sell to some eastern states that require a negative test for either or both diseases.
7. Individual health certificates ****3 copies each**** are required for each animal or lot in the sale.
8. All cattle must be ready for interstate travel. We suggest if you are interested in sending cattle to other countries like Canada have the proper test done to allow sale cattle to be exportable.
9. PLEASE HAVE YOUR VET CONTACT THE COLORADO STATE VETERINARIAN FOR COMPLETE HEALTH PAPER REQUIREMENTS REQUIRED FORM YOUR STATE.

BRAND REQUIREMENTS

1. All exhibitors coming from mandatory brand inspection states must have a current brand inspection certificate. The original copy of the inspection certificate must be turned in with the health certificate. All animals found to be improperly shipped will be held until released by the state of origin.
2. All out of state exhibitors coming into Colorado for the National Western from non-mandatory brand inspection states must have a legal bill of sale as proof of title accompanying the livestock to and from the National Western Stock Show for exhibition and sale.

CONDUCT OF THIS SPECIAL SALE

1. Stalling will be assigned in the sale cattle area provided in the yards by the National Western Stock Show.
2. Sale cattle must be in yards by Wednesday, January 11th.
3. Sale order will be determined by sale management, sale chairman and auctioneer.
4. Sale cattle will be displayed in designated pens. If you have entered a pen of three (3) or pen of five (5) bulls or pen of three (3) heifers in the Pen Show, you may stall your sale animal in your bull or female pen. If you do not have a pen in the yards, a special pen will be provided for sale animals for tie out. Loose cattle will be provided pens in sale cattle area.
5. Cattle MUST be washed and dried after the auction. Sale cattle must be fed and cared for (kept clean) until loaded for shipment to the new owner. This is the sole responsibility of the consignors.
6. Consignors are expected to make sure their cattle have been taken care of and have secured transportation to their new homes before leaving the NWSS. Buyers are obviously responsible for all transportation costs.
